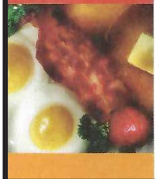

FROM PAST POST MEETING MINUTES

250 Years of the American Military and its War Veterans

Ten Generations of Americans have passed since the signing of the Declaration of Independence by our founding fathers in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. For 230 of those years, our country has been at peace for just 20 years. No wars, no skirmishes, no military actions, no uprisings to quell; just peace. "The mere absence of war is not peace."—President John F. Kennedy. However, there have been "over 240 distinct wars, conflicts, and skirmishes." With a total of 481 "instances in which the United States has used military forces abroad in situations of military conflict or potential conflict to protect U.S. citizens or promote U.S. interests." Congress has declared war 11 times during 5 separate wars. These major conflicts include the War of 1812, the Mexican-American War, the Spanish-American War, World War I, and World War II. Without an act of declaration of war, the other major conflicts and wars have been the American Revolution, the Civil War, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Gulf War, the War in Afghanistan, and the Iraq War. All these conflicts have produced the American Military Veteran. These men and women have protected our democracy and kept America safe. The history of our military starts with the Continental Army, formed by the second Continental Congress on June 14, 1775.

Congress appointed George Washington as the Commander-in-Chief. However, it was not until after the Revolutionary War that Congress officially established the Army on June 3, 1784. On October 13, 1775, the Continental Congress authorized the purchase of two ships, and the United States Navy was born. To assist the Navy in its mission, Congress formed the Marine Corps on November 10, 1775. (more to come on the Navy and Marine Corps in the November/December *PostScripts*). The Air Force can trace its "beginnings" back to August 1, 1907, managed by the Army's Signal Corps. Reorganized into the Air Service United States Army, it became an independent branch of the

military on September 18, 1947. On August 4, 1790, Congress formed the U.S. Coast Guard to prevent smuggling and to enforce U.S. Trade laws. In December 2021, Space Force became the sixth branch of the military. Space Force personnel came from direct transfers from the U.S. Air Force, and space operators from the Army and the Navy.

The American Legion recognizes veterans from all our military branches and strives to provide aid, assistance, and comfort to veterans and active-duty military in need. On Veterans' Day, we recognize, honor, and celebrate our veterans for their military service. On Memorial Day, we decorate the graves of those men who gave the "last full measure of devotion." We remember and honor the memory of our comrades killed during military service to our country.

On an ending note, our country will be celebrating its 250th birthday on July 4, 2026. Our military is why it is still here and will be for the foreseeable future. In conclusion, consider this thought on our veterans.
