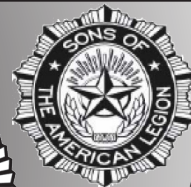

Commander's Corner Mark W. Smith Post 57 Commander

Fellow Legionnaires,

Summer is finally here and we all seem to be enjoying outside activities as much as possible. I hope this edition of the post-scripts finds all of you in good health. We had a very successful May and June, with Poppy Days, Post Everlasting, Cruise Nights, Flag Day, US Army 248th Birthday, Election of Officers, and our Father's Day lunch.



Here are a few good to know items about the American Flag from the American Legion Flag Page www.legion.org/flag as we celebrate Independence Day.

Q: When was Flag Day established?

A: In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day to commemorate the adoption of the U.S. flag on June 14, 1777.

Q: Are you required to destroy the flag if it touches the ground?

A: The Flag Code states that the flag should not touch anything beneath it, including the ground. This is stated to indicate that care should be exercised in the handling of the flag, to protect it from becoming soiled or damaged. You are not required to destroy the flag when this happens. As long as the flag remains suitable for display, you may continue to display the flag as a symbol of our great country.

Q: Can the flag be washed or dry-cleaned?

A: There are no provisions of the Flag Code that prohibit the washing or dry-cleaning of the flag. The decision would depend upon the type of material of the flag.

Q: Who can authorize the flag to be flown at half-staff?

A: Only the president of the United States or the governor of the state may order the flag to be half-staffed, in accordance with Flag Code section 7(m).

The month of July brings Independence Day for us on the 4th, as well as the annual Elgin 4th of July Parade which the Post will be participating in with our Honor Guard, American Legion Riders, and a few other members with military vehicles. Unfortunately, the South Elgin Parade was canceled again this year. On July 29th we will be having our Post Picnic in the parking lot again this year, so I look forward to seeing many of you there. Please look for volunteer sheets near the front doors as we will be needing help to make this fun event happen. I am hearing there are already lots of great raffle prizes collected, so make sure to come out for some great food and fun, and a chance to take home a nice prize.

I was honored to be elected for another term as Commander for 2023-2024. I am humbled and proud to represent you all in the best way I can each and every day. I would like to congratulate the following Legionnaires on their election as Post 57 Officers for the 2023-2024 year.

responsible for Post 57 achieving 102% of our membership goal during this past year.

I am not sure if it has happened in the past, but on August 4th at 7 pm, we will do a Legion Family Installation of Officers at Post 57 where we will Install new officers from the Post, Auxiliary, and the Sons of the America Legion. After the installation, we will have food and entertainment to celebrate the event. I hope to see many members and guests from all of the Legion Family groups attend and help us celebrate on this great occasion.

Veterans will get a cost-of-living boost on their benefit payments next year equal to the annual Social Security cost-of-living adjustment now that President Joe Biden signed a bipartisan bill into law requiring the raise.

The Veterans' Compensation Cost-of-Living Adjustment Act of 2023 directs the Department of Veterans Affairs to boost compensation for service-disabled veterans and the families of fallen service members by providing a cost-of-living adjustment equal to the Social Security increase. President Biden signed the bill at the White House after it was passed unanimously in the House on May 23 and the Senate on March 30.

The law comes after veterans and Social Security recipients saw the largest COLA boost in decades last year, when the Social Security Administration and VA approved an 8.7% raise for this year due to high inflation rates last year.

It was not immediately clear how large a raise veterans would get from the bill. The Social Security Administration is expected to announce its annual cost-of-living adjustment sometime early in the next fiscal year, which begins Oct. 1. The raise is based on the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, according to the Social Security Administration. It would go into effect Dec. 1, 2023, according to the law.

I hope to see everyone coming out and supporting the Post and our groups at the Fish Fry, Cruise Nights, Queen of Hearts, Burger Night, Lightning, Bingo, etc. We are blessed with some awesome Veterans, Auxiliary, Sons and Legion Riders within our post who give many hours of their time to make these events possible for us all to enjoy.

Be looking for your Octoberfest Tickets to come a bit earlier this year. We want to get a jump on membership as soon as we can, so we may be sending these out in the next month or so. As usual, you will get two books of tickets, and the first book sold will cover your Post dues. We are also looking at promoting 5-year memberships this year, and the deal with that would be pay for 4 years and get your fifth year free. Let Gunny know if you are interested.

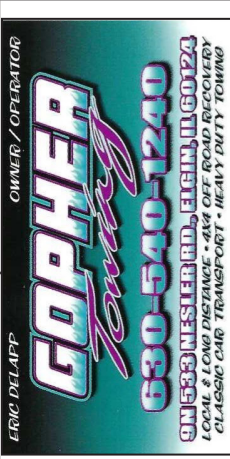
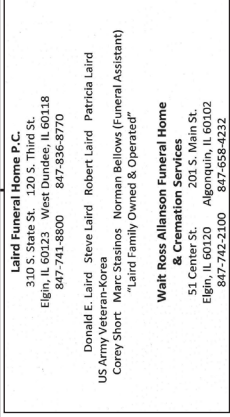
A sign-up sheet for next year is located on the post bulletin board. To increase the league to 36 members, four new players have to join up. The league would enjoy having YOU playing with us every week.

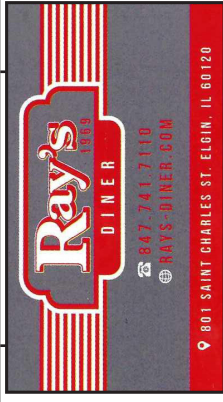
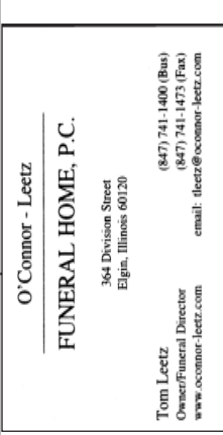
